In applying for an EFT visa slot, the following guidelines should be observed:

1. All missionaries with an EFT visa must work in conjunction with a Thai organization, foreign member organization, or local church that is a member in good standing with EFT. No application will be considered which does not have an organization or a church acting as its sponsor.
2. A job description developed by the organization/church and the prospective missionary must be submitted with this application.
3. All prospective missionaries who want to use an EFT visa slot must have a Bible school degree, diploma or its equivalent.

- There is no fee for applying. If you are approved for a visa, these are the processing fees: a family will pay 16,500 baht and a single person will pay 14,500 baht. Additionally, the family, as well as the single person, must pay a one-time administrative fee of 5,000 baht. Final fees will be for a work permit 3,100 baht and insurance of administration 3,000 baht.

Initial total fees for family: 27,600 baht

Initial total fees for single: 25,600 baht

Total fees for following years: 19,600 baht (family); 17,600 baht

- Please note that a full Thai language version of this application has been included so that Thai sponsoring organizations/churches can easily understand the requirements of the application process. Part 1, which is to be filled in by the sponsoring organization, can be completed on the Thai form.

- A copy of your Bible School Degree, Diploma or equivalent.
- History of applicant (need to answer the questions above to be given to the Religious Affairs)
- If you have previously held a visa with an EFT member organization, please include a letter of reference.
- Please include 3 letters of reference. Each letter should include the name, address and contact phone number or email of the writer and an explanation of their relationship to you. If you have had previous ministry in Thailand at least one reference should be from a Thai pastor or leader you worked with.
